




The Impact of Corruption

Corruption remains the biggest road block to prosperity and equity in Kenya. Kenya loses at least KShs 608 billion, almost 8% of its GDP, directly to Corruption.

See what Kshs 608 billion can do



Kenya's score in the Transparency International Corruption Perceptions Index (100 means there is no Corruption) dropped from 32 to 31 in 2023 compared to 2022. The average size of bribes rose by 50% in 2023 over 2022. Individuals marred by serious integrity issues and active court cases hold critical public service offices. Withdrawals and acquittals by the office of the Director of Public Prosecutions (ODPP) in these cases seriously undermines efforts to fight Corruption.

The direct damage to each one of us

Corruption hurts most Kenyans immeasurably in socially, financially and politically. The vast majority of Kenyans languish in relative poverty with nowhere to turn in this country of immense human and resource wealth.

This lack of opportunity particularly affects the prospects of the youth, who make up the vast majority of Kenya's people. TI–Kenya's strategic plan, "Action for Integrity" (2022–2028), highlights the importance of every citizen's involvement in holding leaders accountable in governing with integrity, transparency, and accountability.

The Integrity Walkathon's intention is to galvanise every Kenyan's support in combating Corruption at every level.



About the Walkathon

The Integrity Walk 2024 is an inclusive effort to demand transparency, accountability, and better service delivery from public institutions. It will take place on 28th September 2024 from 8.30 a.m.

The walk route will pass by key state, religious, law enforcement and political offices that have an impact on governance, including the Office of the Deputy Public Prosecutor (ODPP), Parliament Buildings, various religious institutions, and the Supreme Court. It will end at Uhuru Park.


